Approval for Transfer of CEPF I Balance to CEPF II

Recommended Action Item:

The Donor Council is asked to approve the recommendation of the Secretariat to transfer the remaining balance in CEPF I to be available for investment in CEPF II.

Background:

For the past several years, CEPF has been running CEPF I and II as concurrent programs, even though they were governed by different operational manuals and financing agreements. In June 2011, the Secretariat closed the last grant in the Eastern Himalayas Hotspot and we were able to close the books on CEPF Phase I. As grants concluded, grantees provided unused funding back to CEPF to be used for future programming. This, plus some remaining funding in Operations/Secretariat and Ecosystem Profile Development, resulted in a 1.4 million dollar balance on CEPF I, \$400K of which has been transferred for Haiti emergency relief as approved at the Sixteenth Donor Council meeting and approved by a subsequent no objection electronic consultation that ended on 10 March 2010. As discussed during the development of the Strategic Framework, the Secretariat is proposing that we roll over the remaining funding from CEPF I for use in CEPF II. These funds will return to the general CEPF II funding pool for future programming.
