There is a risk that the project, through conducting meeting and workshop, plays a role in the spread of COVID-19 (or a similar disease). With regard to COVID, it is possible that new variants will arise and spread.

Staff and community volunteers will be travelling along sometime poor roads to get to remote villages. There is a risk of accident, civil unrest or random violence.

CIYA staff and community volunteers will follow latest government health advice. CIYA will ensure that COVID testing is available to people involved in the project. CIYA will play a role in distributing government health advice.

CIYA staff wear helmets on motorbikes. They maintain close communication with each other, so that, if an accident happens, there is timely action. CIYA staff also monitor the situation with regard to civil unrest and take this into account in their activities.
